Prizes and Privileges:

1. There are three prizes for First, Second and Third Positions.
2. The winners will be extended special privileges in Library rules like extended period of retaining the books and getting two books more in addition to the allowed books at one time.
3. The participants who will get the E-Certificate will also be allowed five days more than the allowed period.

Terms and Rules:

- A. The contest is open only for the students of Arya College and those who have registered for any stream for the session 2020-21. The contestants must use the Contest Form to apply. The participants may not use the Contestants form.
- B. The students of Arya College can also join as participants. The Participants will also be given E-Certificate for participation. The participants will become eligible for special Library privileges. The participants may apply by using Participants form.

Rules of the Contest:

1. The paper reading is allowed in any of the three languages namely English, Hindi and Punjabi.
2. The paper reading is allowed only on the topics given above
3. The duration of Paper Reading is up to five minutes.
3. A contestant has to read the paper online through his/her own device like mobile or Laptop/PC. (No pre-recorded Video will be considered for the contest.) The contestants must download Google Meet app on their device on their own or access it through their browser of Gmail Account. They will participate from their home.
4. The Contestant must fill the form online before 24 July 2020.
5. The Winning Contestants must submit their manuscript to the Department of History after the declaration of the result.
6. The decision of the Judges will be final.
7. The non-Contestants can also register for the contest. They will be awarded the participation E-Certificate.
